Dear Friends,

Vengeance is mine, says the Lord. An eye for an eye, a tooth for a tooth.

Which statement do you agree with? How do we respond when we have been hurt by another? James and John clearly were ready to exact vengeance on the Samaritan village which had refused to welcome them. As Galilean Jews, they didn't much like the Samaritans in the first place. This was as good a time as any to get even with those uppity Samaritans who always gave them such a hard time when they had to travel through the Samaritan territory on the way to Jerusalem and points south.

Jesus turned to them and rebuked them and then they all went on their way. This is "turning the other cheek" in action. Sometimes we insist that we're not looking for a fight, we just need to get our point across, or we have the right to speak up for ourselves. That might be true, but what value is there in trying to get a point across to someone who does want to listen to you? Either they will ignore you or just argue.

Jesus would defend a point vigorously if the other person was listening and would get something out of it, but he knew when it was time to just walk away.

May we all have some share in Jesus' wisdom and learn when it is appropriate to speak and when it is better to be silent.
